About The Survival Karate Camp Challenge

Students will be divided up according to age into 4 teams, headed up by two Brown Belt Captains. The team members will consist of White through Brown Belts.

The teams' goals are to set up camp in the woods, and live and work together for 36 hours with very little sleep, food, water while accomplishing different simple to hard challenging team missions.

The Challenge Missions will consist of challenges that the whole team will accomplish. Each complete mission gains your team points. Your team will have the chance to use a compass, map, radio, night vision, cross interesting creeks and valleys in the day and night, rescue hostages, all while defending each other against "The Black Ninjas"

CHECK LIST

Each Team will be issued Two Maps, 1 Radio, 10X25 Foot Sheet of Plastic, Waterproof Matches
1 Plastic Gallon Bag and 23 Foot Small Rope

What do you need? Your Wits, Your Humor and Your Karate all at the same time.

What you can Bring? Clothes on your back, sleeping bag, plastic cover for the sleeping bag, water proof boots, 1- 20 oz of bottle water, rain gear, **flashlight**, & any medications you may need.

What you **can not** bring? Everything Else.

What you will eat? Food for the whole team that will fit in a 1 Gallon Bag

What happens when the camp is OVER We pull everybody out on Sunday at 10am. You will have 30 minutes to take a cold shower brush your teeth and change your clothes. Bring a complete change of comfortable clothes for lunch and your ride home. We will all go to Bubba's Cafe in Cold Spring 6 miles away. They will have a Buffet set up, \$10 per person. (You may be Hungry) You will have time to eat. At this time we will announce the team that won.
